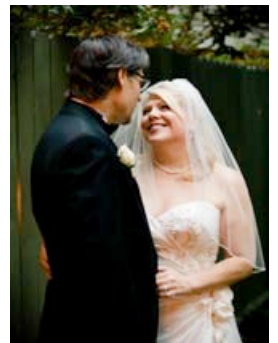




'Breakfast at Tiffany's' Wedding Brunch Package
